Note to Shareholders:

1. The Ministry of Corporate Affairs (MCA) has vide Circular dated January 13, 2021 read with circulars No. 14/2020 dated April 8, 2020, Circular No.17/2020 dated April 13, 2020 and Circular No. 20/2020 dated May 05, 2020 permitted the holding of Annual General Meeting through video conferencing (VC) or other Audio Visual Means (OAVM). Hence, Members can attend and participate in the ensuing AGM through VC/OAVM.
2. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 108 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with Rule 20 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 (as amended) and Regulation 44 of SEBI (Listing Obligations & Disclosure Requirements) Regulations 2015 (as amended), and MCA Circulars dated April 08, 2020, April 13, 2020 and May 05, 2020 the Company is providing facility of remote e-voting to its Members in respect of the business to be transacted at the AGM. For this purpose, the Company has entered into an agreement with Central Depository Services (India) Limited (CDSL) for facilitating voting through electronic means, as the authorized e-Voting's agency. The facility of casting votes by a member using remote e-voting as well as the e-voting system on the date of the AGM will be provided by CDSL.
3. The Members can join the AGM in the VC/OAVM mode 15 minutes before and after the scheduled time of the commencement of the Meeting by following the procedure mentioned in the Notice. The facility of participation at the AGM through VC/OAVM will be made available to at least 1000 members on first come first served basis. This will not include large Shareholders (Shareholders holding 2% or more shareholding), Promoters, Institutional Investors, Directors, Key Managerial Personnel, the Chairpersons of the Audit Committee, Nomination and Remuneration Committee and Stakeholders Relationship Committee, Auditors etc. who are allowed to attend the AGM without restriction on account of first come first served basis.

However, in terms of the provisions of Section 112 and Section 113 of the Act read with the said circulars, Corporate shareholders are entitled to appoint their authorized representative to attend the AGM through VC/OVAM on their behalf and participate thereat,

including cast votes by electronic means. (Details are provided separately below)

4. The attendance of the Members attending the AGM through VC/OAVM will be counted for the purpose of ascertaining the quorum under Section 103 of the Companies Act, 2013.
5. Pursuant to MCA Circular No. 14/2020 dated April 08, 2020, the facility to appoint proxy to attend and cast vote for the members is not available for this AGM. However, in pursuance of Section 112 and Section 113 of the Companies Act, 2013, representatives of the members such as the President of India or the Governor of a State or body corporate can attend the AGM through VC/OAVM and cast their votes through e-voting.
6. In line with the Ministry of Corporate Affairs (MCA) Circular No. 17/2020 dated April 13, 2020, the Notice calling the AGM has been uploaded on the website of the Company at www.southernlatex.in. The Notice can also be accessed from the websites of the Stock Exchange i.e. BSE Limited at www.bseindia.com. The AGM Notice is also disseminated on the website of CDSL (agency for providing the Remote e-Voting facility and e-voting system during the AGM) i.e. www.evotingindia.com.
7. The AGM has been convened through VC/OAVM in compliance with applicable provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 read with MCA Circular No. 14/2020 dated April 8, 2020 and MCA Circular No. 17/2020 dated April 13, 2020 and MCA Circular No. 20/2020 dated May 05, 2020.
8. In continuation of this Ministry's **General Circular No. 20/2020**, dated 05th May, 2020 and after due examination, it has been decided to allow companies whose AGMs were due to be held in the year 2020, or become due in the year 2021, to conduct their AGMs on or before 31.12.2021, in accordance with the requirements provided in paragraphs 3 and 4 of the General Circular No. 20/2020 as per MCA circular no. 02/2021 dated January,13,2021.
9. The Register of Members and the Share Transfer books of the Company will remain closed from Thursday, 23rd September, 2021 to Wednesday 29th September 2021 (both days inclusive) for the purpose of determining the Members eligible for voting.

10. Members are requested to notify immediately any change in their address to the Company in case their shares held in dematerialized form; this information should be passed so that the information required can be made readily available at the meeting.
11. Members holding shares in physical form are requested to de-materialize the shares in electronic form to facilitate faster transfer and avoid rejections for bad deliveries. THE INSTRUCTIONS OF SHAREHOLDERS FOR E-VOTING AND JOINING VIRTUAL MEETINGS ARE AS UNDER:

- (i) The voting period begins on 26th September, 2021 9.00 A.M. and ends on 28th September, 2021 at 5.00 P.M. During this period shareholders' of the Company, holding shares either in physical form or in dematerialized form, as on the cut-off date (record date) of 22nd September, 2021 cast their vote electronically. The e-voting module shall be disabled by CDSL for voting thereafter.
- (ii) Shareholders who have already voted prior to the meeting date would not be entitled to vote at the meeting venue.
- (iii) Pursuant to SEBI Circular No. **SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD/CIR/P/2020/242 dated 09.12.2020**, under Regulation 44 of Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, listed entities are required to provide remote e-voting facility to

its shareholders, in respect of all shareholders' resolutions. However, it has been observed that the participation by the public non-institutional shareholders/retail shareholders is at a negligible level.

Currently, there are multiple e-voting service providers (ESPs) providing e-voting facility to listed entities in India. This necessitates registration on various ESPs and maintenance of multiple user IDs and passwords by the shareholders.

In order to increase the efficiency of the voting process, pursuant to a public consultation, it has been decided to enable e-voting to **all the demat account holders, by way of a single login credential, through their demat accounts/ websites of Depositories/ Depository Participants.** Demat account holders would be able to cast their vote without having to register again with the ESPs, thereby, not only facilitating seamless authentication but also enhancing ease and convenience of participating in e-voting process.

- (iv) In terms of **SEBI circular no. SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD/CIR/P/2020/242** dated December 9, 2020 on e-Voting facility provided by Listed Companies, Individual shareholders holding securities in demat mode are allowed to vote through their demat account maintained with Depositories and Depository Participants. Shareholders are advised to update their mobile number and email Id in their demat accounts in order to access e-Voting facility.

5. Further shareholders will be required to allow Camera and use Internet with a good speed to avoid any disturbance during the meeting.
6. Please note that Participants Connecting from Mobile Devices or Tablets or through Laptop connecting via Mobile Hotspot may experience Audio/Video loss due to Fluctuation in their respective network. It is therefore recommended to use Stable Wi-Fi or LAN Connection to mitigate any kind of aforesaid glitches.
7. Explanatory Statement pursuant to Section 102 of the Companies Act, 2013

Resolution No.3:

Mr. Neelakanda Pillai was appointed as the Managing Director of the Company with effect from 18th December 2019. Mr. Neelakanda Pillai was appointed as a Director liable to retire by rotation as the Company has two directors liable to retire by rotation. The present term of Mr. Neelakanda Pillai as Managing Director comes to an end on 31st March, 2022. The Board has proposed, upon the recommendation of the Nomination and Remuneration Committee and subject to the approval of the Members, the re-appointment of Mr. Neelakanda Pillai as Managing Director for a further period of five years ending on 31st March 2027. Mr. Neelakanda Pillai is not disqualified from being re-appointed as a Director in terms of Section 164 of the Act and has given his consent to act as Managing Director of the Company. Mr. Neelakanda Pillai satisfies all the conditions as set out in Section 196[3] of the Act and Part-I of Schedule V to the Act, for being eligible for his appointment.

Mr. Neelakanda Pillai is deemed to be interested in the respective appointment. No other Director or Key managerial Personnel of the Company or their relatives are interested, financially or otherwise in the aforesaid Special Resolution.

The Company had, pursuant to the provisions of section 149 of Companies Act, 2013 and Regulation 17 LODR Regulation 2015, appointed Ms Santhi, as the Independent Director of the Company. The Company pursuant to the provisions of section 149 of Companies Act, 2013 had appointed Ms Santhi, as the Independent Director of the Company. Her period of appointment was till 31st March 2020 and the Board at its meeting held on 12th February 2020 has reappointed her for another 5 years as Independent and Woman Director. Her said appointment was required to be approved by the shareholders at the AGM held in 2020. However due to Covid pandemic and lock down the situation everywhere was uncertain.
